

## **SUFFOLK JUNIOR OPEN 2010**

There will be separate sections and trophies for every age group between under 7 and under 15. Under 16's, 17's and 18's play in the Open section.

A novices section is available for young players with little chess playing experience.

Adults are encouraged to play in the open section against the stronger juniors, usually from the Under 16, 17 and 18 age groups.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Entrants should normally play in their own age group. This is based on their age on 31 August 2009

Monetary prizes will be available to all comers. Annual trophies will be presented to the highest placed player in each age group who either:

- Attends school in Suffolk
- Lives in Suffolk
- Is a bona fide member of a Suffolk Chess Club

### **RATE OF PLAY**

The rate of play for all sections will be 30 minutes per player per game. Clocks will be used on all boards, assistance will be provided where needed.

## DIRECTIONS

- Approaching from Colchester or Bury St Edmunds follow the A14 over the Orwell Bridge then take the 2nd left onto the A12 towards Lowestoft. Cross over 5 roundabouts and at the sixth (by Wyevale garden centre) turn right and continue down to the T junction. Turn right and Woodbridge School is 200yds on left.
- Approaching from Lowestoft on the A12 cross over the roundabout that has Melton signed to the left. Pass the Shell garage and at the next roundabout turn left. Continue down to the T junction. Turn right and Woodbridge School is 200yds on left.
